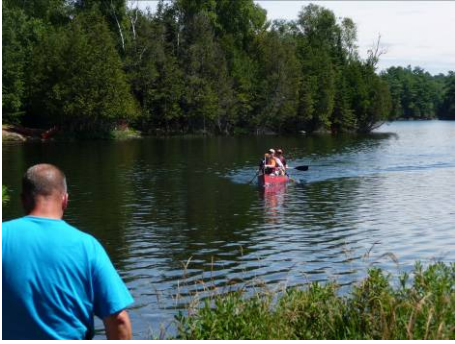


Do you dream of being up north? The sound of paddles stirring the water? Of taking your youth to one of Scouts Canada's premier camps?

We have secured 2 sites for our upcoming year, Ojibway and Sejur, with Venturers camping at Ojibway, the Scouts at Sejur and kitchen and eating area also at Sejur. These locations are ideally set up for a quick paddle between.

So come and join us for a week of fun and adventure and meet new friends. We don't think you'll be disappointed.

When: July 28 - Aug 4 2012

What you need to bring: – youth, troop gear – tents, kybo facilities/equipment; personal gear. No food or cooking equipment necessary, although you might want to bring a campstove and kettle for your Troop's camp area.

Why would you want to be a part of our week? Our composite camp set up allows you to spend the most amount of time with your youth attending activities. The planning, grocery shopping, and cooking is looked after for you.



What is the cost to you? \$345.00 for each attendee. Includes everything. (really!) Includes bus transportation to and from camp, lunch on return trip, all meals and activities. We ask that all leaders assist with food serving and clean up on a rotating basis for all meals.

How do you sign up? Let us know that you're interested and how many will be in your Troop and send your \$100/participant deposit by the 9<sup>th</sup> of February. Reservations will be taken on a first come first served basis as we can only accommodate about 80 participants.
