Badge Work

I would like to remind youth that you are responsible for presenting any badge work that you have accomplished. If we cover something in a meeting or a camp it will not be entered into Scout Tracker until you present it to a leader. Sometimes that can be as simple as saying you were there. Sometimes it will involve answering some questions, other times it will require some kind of presentation. There is a sign up sheet at our meetings. Sign in and we will do our best to get your badge work done that night. If you find you have a large backlog of work to present, let me know (preferably by email), and we will make some arrangements to get your work presented outside of a meeting.

<u>Dues</u>

Another reminder is that dues should be paid each week. If you forget one week try to pay the following week. Dues are payable even for weeks that you are not present. If you are not sure if you owe or know please check with your Patrol leader during Patrol time at the beginning of the meeting. It should be recorded in the Patrol folder.

Dues are used to fund our weekly program. Some weeks cost the Troop nothing and others cost us more than we collect in dues. This is why we need to collect them for each week.

Ongoing Fundraisers

A final reminder is about ongoing fundraisers. We have two that we use on an ongoing basis: pop cans and Zehrs tapes.

Pop cans are taken to a local recycler where we exchange them for cash. Pleas bring in the cans in a bag with the cans rinsed and crushed. If you have large bag please let me know ahead of time so I can make sure I have room to take them.

Zehrs tapes are from the Bolton store only. Please hand them in to me and I will get them to those that sort them out for us. Every dollar helps so do not think that small totals are a waste.
